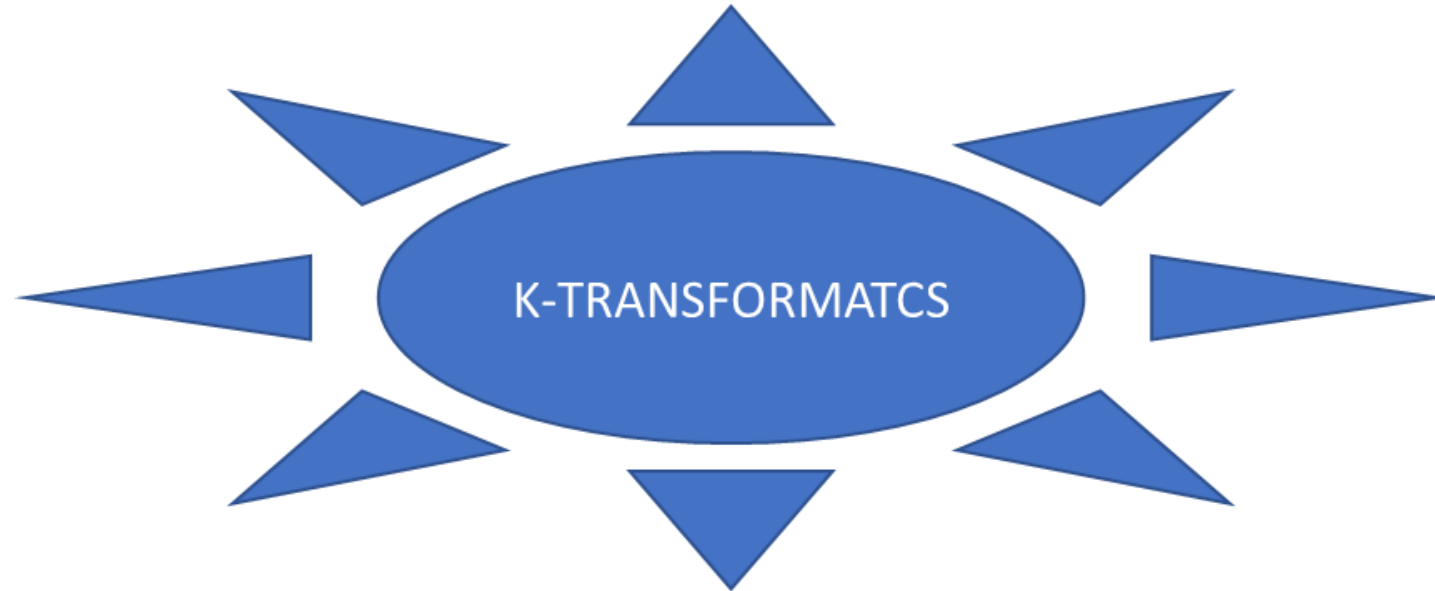

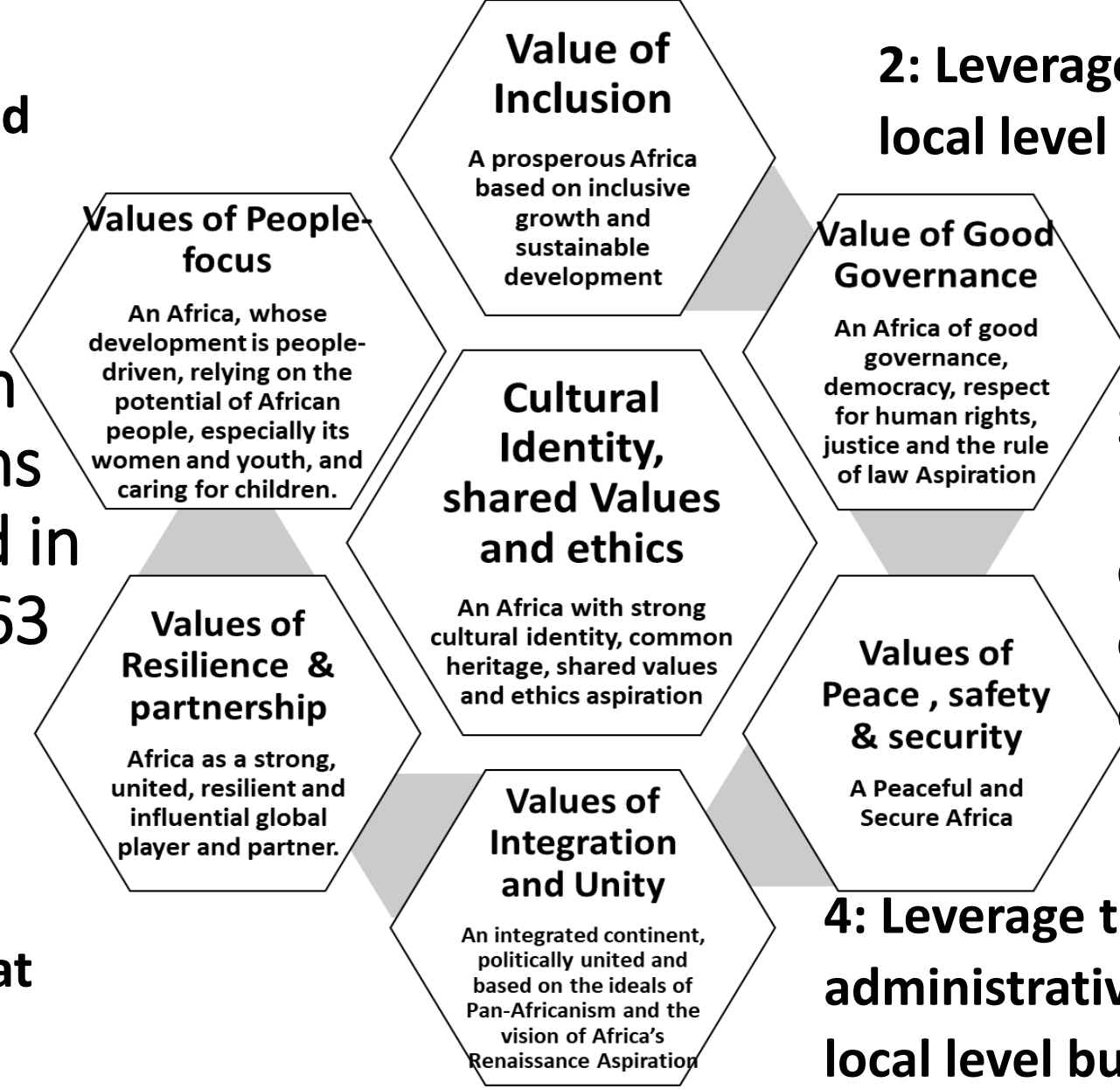

7: Leverage the revenue generation capacity of local communities and local governments: Stop taking local governments as expenditure items on government budgets

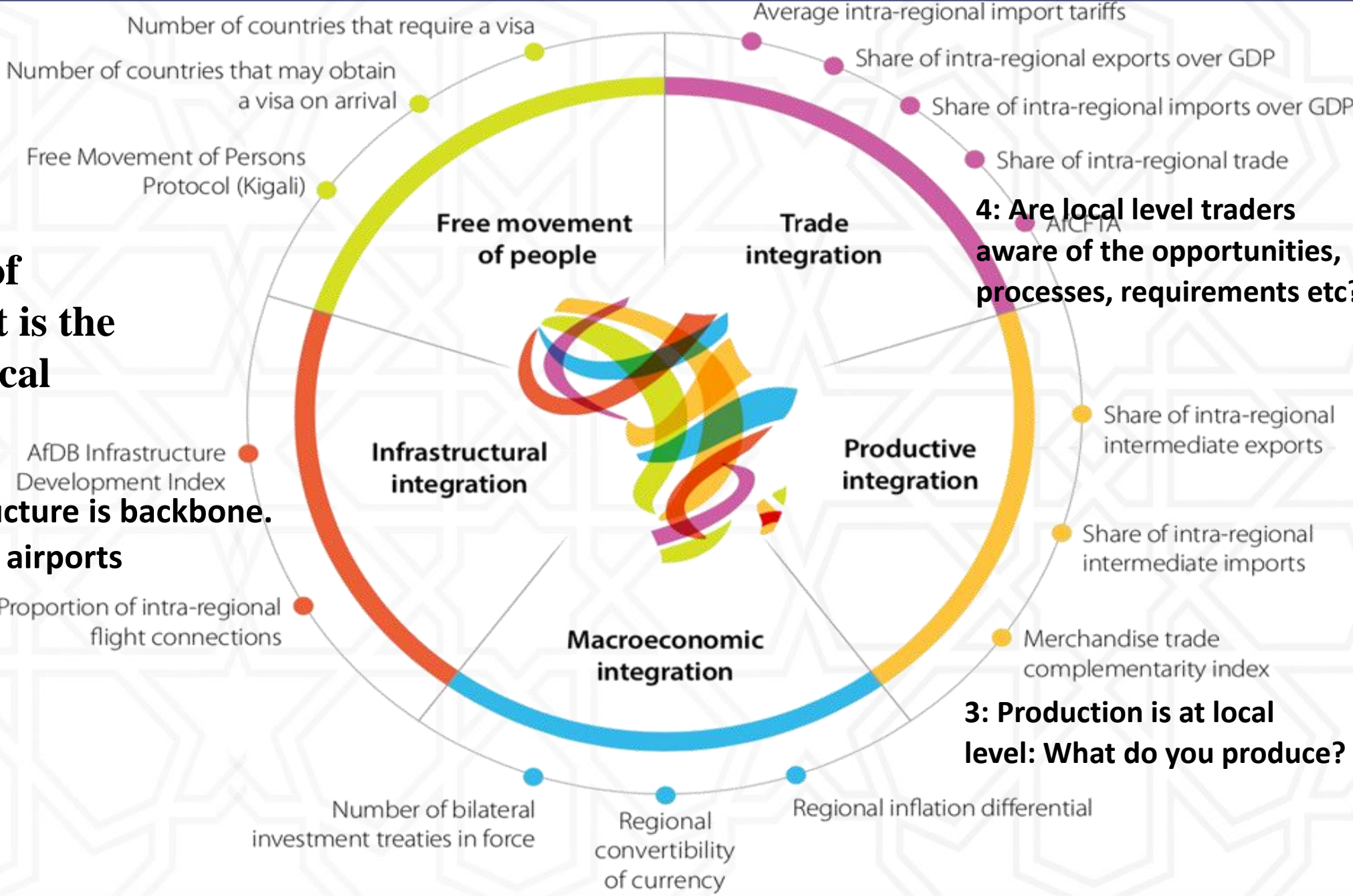
1: How welcoming are local communities and authorities: VISA removal does not remove xenophobia.
